- The Committee would also enjoy and brainstorming sessions with other committees or groups on campus about AI.
- All is being used on the Student Service side. There is a Chatbot that uses All to provide student support 24/7. This bot is trained on internal TMCC documentation.
- Listening Post/Organized conversations about AI.
 - Make sure tech is solid so all can hear for hybrid sessions.
 - Consider 2 sessions instead in-person and online as separate sessions.
 - Do outreach sessions at various campuses and consider varied formats (brown bag lunch, coffee meet-up).
- Tech Day on the Hill will not have a dedicated AI representation. We have scheduled Reed Dickson to return to TMCC this coming Spring (tentatively February). We will setup special sessions for specific stakeholders and groups.
- Reach out to CSN and their AI Task Force chair to see who might be interested/willing to host a webinar.
- ITC & WCET have an affinity group with some people that may be willing to do webinars.
- Pikes Peak CC has an AI book club that TMCC might consider mirroring.

Technology Training:

- Fred Lokken led a discussion about the possibility of a training day for faculty Feb 20/21, 2025. This would be with Reed Dickson who has provided trainings for TMCC in the past. The difference this time around would be that the trainings would be more hands-on, they would be longer sessions, and would focus on instructional faculty.
